This role provides leadership, supervision and guidance to a transdisciplinary care team located in a long term care home which provides hospice, respite and long term care as well as a palliative care resource team which supports health care providers, individuals, families/friends and volunteers through education, consultation and coordination in order to promote an integrated palliative care approach across all settings.

Your first challenge in this role will be supporting the opening of the new Wind River Hospice, located within Whistle Bend, the brand-new continuing care facility. You will manage setup tasks, including the development of operational policies and procedures and human resources planning. In addition to these short-term responsibilities, in the long-term, you will be responsible to plan, develop, lead and supervise the service delivery of the community hospice and long-term care program.
